17 Correctional Center in Big Spring, Texas. To date, plaintiff has filed more than one hundred civil  
18 cases in this district. Plaintiff is an abusive litigant who persists in filing baseless actions in this  
19 district.<sup>1</sup> As with the multitude of previous actions filed by Plaintiff, the complaint in this action is  
20 rambling and incoherent, and fails to state any cognizable claims under federal law. Bell Atl. Corp.  
v. Twombly, 127 S. Ct. 1955, 1965 (2007).21 This action is HEREBY DISMISSED, WITH PREJUDICE.
