DEFENDANTS MCCAVE, O'BRIEN, AND  
GARZA, WITH PREJUDICE, PURSUANT  
TO PARTIES' STIPULATION

Plaintiff Thomas John Carlson, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on April 30, 2010. This action is proceeding on Plaintiff's third amended complaint, filed on November 6, 2013, against fifteen defendants, all of whom have appeared. On December 4, 2014, the parties filed a stipulation to dismiss the claims against Defendants McCave, O'Brien, and Garza, with prejudice. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). Accordingly, pursuant to the parties' stipulation, the claims against Defendants McCave, O'Brien, and Garza are DISMISSED with prejudice, and each party shall bear his or her own litigation costs and attorney's fees. *Id.*
