which the action may otherwise be brought." 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b).

In this case none of the defendants reside in this district. The claim arose in San Luis Obispo County in the Central District of California. Plaintiff's claim should have been filed in the United States District Court for the Central District of California.

In the interest of justice, a federal court may transfer a complaint filed in the wrong district to

1	the correct district. See 28 U.S.C. § 1406(a); Starnes v. McGuire, 512 F.2d 918, 932 (D.C. Cir.
2	1974).

4	District Court for the Central District of California.
