The matter 18 19 was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 21 On September 25, 2014, the Magistrate Judge issued Findings and Recommendations that recommended Plaintiff's motion for temporary restraining order and preliminary injunction be 22 DENIED. The Findings and Recommendation was served on all parties and contained notice 23 that any objections were to be filed within thirty (30) days. Over thirty days have passed and no 24 25 party has filed objections. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted 26

a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds that the

Findings and Recommendations are supported by the record and by proper analysis.
