On July 29, 15 2013, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss. (ECF No. 62.) On November 11, 2013, the Court 16 issued a third extension of time to grant Plaintiff an additional thirty days to file an opposition. 17 (ECF No. 69.) More than thirty days has passed, and Plaintiff has not filed an opposition or a 18 statement of non-opposition to the motion. Local Rule 230(*l*). 19 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that: 20 Plaintiff shall file an opposition or a statement of non-opposition to the motion 1. 21 within fourteen (14) days from the date of service of this order; and 22 /// 23 /// 24 /// 25 /// 26 ///
