SHALL be produced to the opposing party no later than May 3, 2013; 3. The original and four copies of all trial exhibits, along with exhibit lists, **SHALL** be submitted to the Courtroom Deputy no later than October 4, 2013; 4. The parties **SHALL** file jury voir dire questions and a statement of the case, no later than **September 27, 2013**; 5. Defendants **SHALL** file proposed jury instructions and a proposed verdict form no later than **September 6, 2013**. If Plaintiff also wishes to file proposed jury instructions or a proposed verdict form or object to those proposed by Defendants, he must do so on or before September 27, 2013. Strict compliance with the pretrial order and its requirements is mandatory. All parties and their counsel are subject to sanctions, including dismissal or entry of default, for failure to fully comply with this order and its requirements. IT IS SO ORDERED. /s/ Jennifer L.
