On 15 February 11, 2013, Plaintiff filed a motion to submit documents Defendants had requested 16 of her during her deposition. (ECF No. 40.) 17 The Court does not involve itself in the ordinary course of discovery. In addition, the 18 Court does not serve as a repository for the parties' evidence (i.e., prison or medical 19 records, affidavits, etc.).
