(Doc. 64.) Defendant 18 Comcast Corporation. ("Comcast") filed an opposition on September 26, 2011. (Doc. 75.) 19 Plaintiffs filed their Reply Brief on October 14, 2011. (Doc. 78.) The matter was referred to United 20 States Magistrate Judge Barbara A. McAuliffe pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 21 302. The Court heard oral arguments on the matter on November 18, 2011. 22 On January 3, 2012, United States Magistrate Judge Barbara A. McAuliffe issued Findings 23 and Recommendations recommending Plaintiffs' motion for class certification be denied. (Doc. 86.) 24 The January 3, 2012 findings and Recommendations were served on the parties and contained notice 25 to the parties that any objections to the Findings and Recommendations were to be filed within 26 27 <sup>1</sup> Counsel Kevin Ruf and Coby Turner appeared for Plaintiffs. fifteen days of service of the Order. (Doc. 86, 31: 19-22.) The parties have not filed timely objections to the Findings and Recommendations. In accordance with the provisions of Title 28 of the United States Code section 636(b)(1)(c), this Court has conducted a *de novo* review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds that the Findings and Recommendations are supported by the record and proper analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The Findings and Recommendations, filed January 3, 2012, is adopted in full; 2. Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification is DENIED. IT IS SO ORDERED. /s/ Lawrence J. O'Neill
