On June 16, 2010, the Court found that Plaintiff was not entitled to proceed in forma 12 13 pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g) and ordered Plaintiff to pay the \$350.00 filing fee in full within thirty days. (ECF No. 3.) More than thirty days have passed and Plaintiff has not complied 14 with or otherwise responded to the Court's order. Plaintiff was warned that dismissal would occur 15 if he failed to obey the order. 16 17 A civil action may not proceed absent payment of the filing fee or the grant of in forma pauperis status. 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914, 1915. Because Plaintiff is not entitled to proceed in forma 18 19 pauperis and has not paid the filing fee, dismissal of this action is appropriate. Phenylpropanolamine (PPA) Products Liability Litigation, 460 F.3d 1217, 1226 (9th Cir. 2006); 20 21 Local Rule 11-110.
