19	The United States of America, Plaintiff herein, applies for an order of publication as
20	follows:
21	1. Rule G(4) of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime Claims and Asset
22	Forfeiture Actions (hereafter "Supplemental Rules") provides that the Plaintiff shall cause public
23	notice of the action to be given in a newspaper of general circulation or on the official internet
24	government forfeiture site;
25	2. Local Rule 171, Eastern District of California, provides that the Court shall
26	designate by order the appropriate newspaper or other vehicle for publication;
27	3. The defendants approximately \$12,700.00 in U.S. Currency and approximately
28	\$7,235.00 in U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant currency") were seized in the city of Delhi,

1	Stanislaus County, California, and are in the custody of the U.S. Marshals Service, Eastern
2	District of California. The Drug Enforcement Administration published notice of the
3	nonjudicial forfeiture of the defendant currency on March 15, 22, and 29, 2010, in the Wall Street
4	Journal.
5	4. Plaintiff proposes that publication be made as follows:
6	a. One publication;
7	b. Thirty (30) consecutive days;
8	c. On the official internet government forfeiture site <u>www.forfeiture.gov</u> ;
9	d. The publication is to include the following:
10	(1) The Court and case number of the action;
11	(2) The date of the seizure/posting;
12	(3) The identity and/or description of the property seized/posted;
13	(4) The name and address of the attorney for the Plaintiff;
14	(5) A statement that claims of persons entitled to possession or
15	claiming an interest pursuant to Supplemental Rule G(5) must be filed with the Court and served
16	on the attorney for the Plaintiff no later than 60 days after the first day of publication on the
17	official internet government forfeiture site; and
18	(6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion under Rule
19	12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed and served within 21
20	days after the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof, default may be entered and
21	condemnation ordered.
