17 On January 31, 2011, this Court set forth an Order Finding Service of Amended
18 Complaint Appropriate, Directing Plaintiff to Correct Caption, and Setting Forth Procedure for
19 Service of Defendants (Doc. 4) (the "order"). On February 4, 2011, Plaintiff filed a Second
20 Amended Prisoner Civil Rights Complaint, which complied with that portion of the order that
21 required Plaintiff to file a corrected complaint, the caption of which set forth the names of all
22 Defendants (Doc. 5). At the same time, this Court was advised that it had erred in describing
23 Plaintiff as proceeding *in forma pauperis* since Plaintiff had paid in full the filing fee for her
24 complaint.

1 Accordingly, this Court hereby vacates paragraph 4 of the Order, which provided for
2 service of the complaint in accordance with procedures applicable to plaintiffs proceeding *in*
3 *forma pauperis*. The Clerk is directed to provide Plaintiff with eleven summonses as well as
4 appropriate directions for Plaintiff's service of the eleven named Defendants.¹
