

1. Plaintiff's opening brief filed February 25, 2011, was timely filed *nunc pro tunc*;
2. Defendant shall serve an opposition no later than **March 28, 2011**; and
3. Plaintiff shall then file any reply to the opposition no later than **April 11, 2011**.

5 Lastly, the Court notes an apparent pattern wherein Plaintiff's attorney ignores the fact
6 deadlines have passed, and fails to articulate any basis that establishes good cause for the request.
7 Although the Court granted this request in this instance, failure to obey future court orders and/or
8 Local Rules may result in the imposition of sanctions. Future requests for continuances are
9 conditioned on proper adherence to the rules..
