18	Lupe Nieto, Jr. ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis with a		
19	civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed his Amended Complaint in this action		
20	on November 17, 2010. (Doc. 9). The Court screened Plaintiff's Amended Complaint pursuant to		
21	28 U.S.C. §1915A, and found that it states cognizable claims against defendant Drake Hodge on		
22	Fourth and Fourteenth Amendment claims related to the use of excessive force. ¹ See Fed.R.Civ.P.		
23	8(a); Erickson v. Pardus, 127 S.Ct. 2197, 2200 (2007); Alvarez v. Hill, 518 F.3d 1152, 1157-58 (9th		
24	Cir. 2008). If the allegations in Plaintiff's Amended Complaint are proven, Plaintiff has a reasonable		
25	opportunity of prevailing on the merits of this claim.		
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28	¹ In separate order issued concurrently with this Order, the Court dismissed the other claims raised in Plaintiff's Amended Complaint for failure to state a claim, and dismissed the City of Clovis, County of Fresno, and "Doe" defendants.		
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1	Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:		
2	1.	Service of Plaintiff's amended complaint is appropriate for, and shall be initiated on	
3		the following defendant: Drake Hodge.	
4	2.	The Clerk of the Court shall send Plaintiff one (1) USM-285 form, one (1) summons,	
5		a Notice of Submission of Documents form, an instruction sheet and a copy of the	
6		Amended Complaint filed November 17, 2010.	
7	3.	Within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, Plaintiff shall complete the	
8		attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the completed Notice to the	
9		Court with the following documents:	
10		a. One completed summons for the defendant listed above;	
11		b. One completed USM-285 form for the defendant listed above; and	
12		c. Two (2) copies of the endorsed amended complaint filed November 17, 2010.	
13	4.	Plaintiff need not attempt service on the defendant and need not request waiver of	
14		service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the Court will direct the	
15		United States Marshal to serve the above-named defendant pursuant to Federal Rule	
16		of Civil Procedure 4 without payment of costs.	
17	5.	Plaintiff is cautioned that failure to comply with this order will result in a	
18		recommendation that this action be dismissed with prejudice.
