1 **ORDER**

3 Based upon the stipulation of the parties, the oral representation to the Court
4 by Defendants' counsel that they will not file a dispositive motion and good cause
5 appearing, the Court ORDERS:

6 1. The Scheduling Order is amended as follows:

7 a. Discovery pertaining to non-experts shall be completed on or
8 before July 13, 2012;

9 b. Discovery pertaining to experts shall be completed on or before
10 July 13, 2012;

11 c. The parties SHALL jointly disclose in writing, all expert
12 witnesses on or before May 15, 2012 and SHALL disclose all rebuttal experts on
13 or before June 15, 2012. The written designation of experts shall be made pursuant
14 to Fed. R.Civ.P. Rule 26(a)(2), (A) and (B) and shall include all information
15 required thereby.

16 2. No other amendments to the scheduling order are authorized;

17 3. **No further amendments to the scheduling order will be permitted**
18 **absent a showing of exceptional good cause.**
