Plaintiff is a prisoner proceeding pro se in a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

On October 19, 2011, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting a pretrial / status conference and permission to start discovery. Doc. 29. On October 24, 2011, the Court issued a discovery and scheduling order. Doc. 30. Moreover, pro se prisoner cases are not subject to conference requirements of Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(f). Thus, Plaintiff's request for discovery and a status conference is not necessary per the discovery and scheduling order issued October 24, 2011.

Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion is DENIED as moot.
