17 Plaintiff Oscar Jones is proceeding in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.  
18 On September 15, 2010, plaintiff filed a motion to proceed in forma pauperis. Plaintiff avers that he  
19 is a civil detainee in the custody of the Department of Mental Health at Coalinga State Hospital, and  
20 is not a convicted prisoner in the custody of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation.  
21 Accordingly, pursuant to Page v. Torrey, 201 F.3d 1136, 1140 (9th Cir. 1999), plaintiff is not  
22 required to pay the filing fee in full as set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b).

23 Good cause having been shown, plaintiff's motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis in  
24 this action is HEREBY GRANTED.
