13	Plaintiff Nathan Smith ("Plaintiff") is a federal prisoner proceeding pro se and in	
14	forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents	
15	of Federal Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388, 91 S.Ct. 1999 (1971).	
16	On December 21, 2010, Plaintiff filed a Motion to Issue Emergency Temporary	
17	Restraining Order asking the Court to order that his personal items be returned. (ECF No.	
18	29.) On January 7, 2011, Plaintiff filed a Motion to Withdraw Motion for Temporary	
19	Restraining Order asking the Court to "strike[], render[] moot and grant[] withdrawal of his	
20	preceding motion." Plaintiff alleges that he has received new information that counters the	
21	allegations made in his prior Motion.	
22	For the reasons stated above, Plaintiff's Motion to Withdraw is GRANTED. The	
23	Clerk shall strike Plaintiff's Motion to Issue Emergency Temporary Restraining Order.
