16	Plaintiff Garrick Harrington ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in		
17	forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff initiated this		
18	action on September 30, 2010. (ECF No. 1.) On May 20, 2013, Plaintiff filed a motion for the		
19	Court to locate Plaintiff's property and transfer it to Solano State Prison, where he was transferred		
20	on April 22, 2013. (ECF Nos. 12 & 14.)		
21	In the Court's experience, prison transfers result in inmates being temporarily separated		
22	from their personal property for up to one month or longer. By now, Plaintiff should be		
23	possession of whatever personal property is allowable based on his classification level and		
24	housing assignment. Moreover, the Court's previous order granted Plaintiff an extension of time		
25	to file an amended complaint. (ECF No. 16.)		
26	However, regardless of the pendency of this action, the Court does not have jurisdiction		
27	over prison officials in general or over Plaintiff's property issues. Summers v. Earth Island		
28	1		

1	Institute, 129 S.Ct. 1142, 1148-49 (2009); Mayfield v. United States, 599 F.3d 964, 969 (9th Cir.	
2	2010). The Court's jurisdiction is limited to the parties in this action and to the viable legal	
3	claims upon which this action is proceeding. <u>Summers</u> , 129 S.Ct. at 1148-49; <u>Mayfield</u> , 599 F.3d	
4	at 969. Accordingly,	
5	Plaintiff's motion is HEREBY DENIED.
