

1 such offensive conduct by Plaintiff. It appears that Plaintiff is contrite. However, **the Court**
2 **cannot warn Plaintiff strongly enough that any further behavior by him that is directed at**
3 **opposing counsel or that occurs in counsel's presence that is demeaning, sexually harassing**
4 **or provocative WILL NOT be tolerated. The Court WILL address any further such**
5 **behavior by issuing severe sanctions, up to and including termination of this action.**

6 Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS**:

- 7 1. Defendants' motion for court intervention, filed on February 16, 2016 (Doc. 167),
8 is **GRANTED**;
- 9 2. Plaintiff **SHALL NOT** engage in any further behavior toward or around
10 opposing counsel (the current assigned attorney or attorney substituted in her
11 place) that is inappropriate, demeaning, and/or sexually harassing or provocative;
12 and
- 13 3. the Order to Show Cause, issued on February 18, 2016 (Doc. 168), is
14 **DISCHARGED**.
