Based upon the foregoing, the Court **GRANTS** the application and **ORDERS**;

- 1. The parties **SHALL** make their expert disclosure no later than October 2, 2012. The disclosures **SHALL** be complete and **SHALL** be accompanied by all expert reports <u>except</u> the expert report of Linda Reynolds **SHALL** be provided no later than October 16, 2012;
- 2. Plaintiff is granted until **November 2, 2012** to disclose any experts intended to rebut the testimony of Linda Reynolds;
 - 3. No other modifications to the scheduling order are authorized.
