**ORDER GRANTING
STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES
FOR:**

- 1. DISCHARGE AND DISMISSAL OF PRIMERICA WITH PREJUDICE;**
- 2. PERMANENT INJUNCTION;
AND**
- 3. AWARD OF REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS TO PRIMERICA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,000**

[Filed concurrently with Stipulation of the Parties]

(Complaint Filed: October 13, 2010)

1 Having considered the Stipulation of Plaintiff-in-Interpleader Primerica Life
2 Insurance Company (“Primerica”) and Defendants-in-Interpleader Jill Davila and
3 Maycelle Davila (collectively “Defendants-in-Interpleader”), the Court **ORDERS** as
4 follows:

5
6 1. That Primerica and its agents are discharged of all liability with respect
7 to life insurance policy number 0467164489 (the “Policy”) issued by Primerica to
8 Jill, with coverage on Jill’s life in the amount of \$150,000 and coverage on Larry
9 Davila’s life in the amount of \$500,000, and out of which this interpleader action
10 arises, as well as discharged of all liability with respect to the distributed Policy
11 proceeds and the payment of the distributed Policy proceeds;

12
13 2. That Defendants-in-Interpleader, and each of them, their agents,
14 attorneys or assigns, are enjoined perpetually, restraining each of them, their agents,
15 attorneys or assigns, from instituting any suit at law or equity, or action of any kind
16 whatsoever against Primerica, and/or its agents, with respect to the Policy and/or the
17 distributed Policy proceeds; and/or the payment of the distributed Policy proceeds;

18
19 3. That Primerica is dismissed from this action with prejudice as to all
20 claims relating to the Policy issued to Jill insuring the life of the Deceased, the
21 distributed Policy proceeds and the payment of the distributed Policy proceeds; and

2 4. That Primerica is awarded its reasonable attorneys' fees and costs in the
3 amount of \$23,000, which Primerica was forced to incur in bringing its interpleader
4 action and defending the claims of the Defendants-in-Interpleader, and which amount
5 is to be paid from the Policy proceeds currently on deposit with this Court.
