On February 8, 2016, Plaintiff filed a 16 notice of appeal (ECF No. 75) and a motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal 17 (ECF No. 79). 18 On May 18, 2016, the Ninth Circuit issued an order revoking Plaintiff's IFP status 19 on appeal because he has had three or more prior actions or appeals dismissed as 20 frivolous, malicious, or for failure to state a claim, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). The 21 Ninth Circuit directed Plaintiff to pay the \$505.00 filing fee to the district court within 21 22 days after the date of its order. 23 Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal (ECF No. 24 79) is HEREBY DENIED as moot. 25 IT IS SO ORDERED. 26 Ist Michael V.
