The case 18 was removed from state court on October 14, 2010. 19 20 On December 30, 2014, Defendants Brazelton, Bennett, Nash, Lantz, Myers, Allen, McGee, Yates and McBride filed an answer to the fourth amended complaint. (ECF No. 64.) On January 5, 21 22 2015, the Court issued a discovery and scheduling order, setting the following deadlines: Exhaustion 23 Motion Filing Deadline: April 5, 2015; Deadline to Amend Pleadings: July 5, 2015; Discovery 24 Deadline: September 5, 2015; and Dispositive Motion Deadline: November 16, 2015. (ECF No. 68.) On May 8, 2015, Defendants Farkas, Shimmin, Fisher, Walker, Sobee, Huckabay and Trimble 25 filed an answer to the fourth amended complaint. (ECF No. 96.) 26 27 The Court's January 5, 2015, discovery and scheduling order shall be extended to Defendants

Farkas, Shimmin, Fisher, Walker, Sobee, Huckabay and Trimble, and the deadline to file an
