On June 4, 2015, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and 21 Recommendation which was served on the parties and which contained notice to the parties that objections to the Findings and Recommendation were to be filed within thirty days. No objections 22 23 were filed. 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and 25 26 Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. 27 ///

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Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The Findings and Recommendations, filed on June 4, 2015, is adopted in full; 2. Defendant Dutra's December 15, 2014, motion for summary judgment is DENIED as MOOT; 3. Defendant Dutra's February 25, 2015, motion for summary judgment is GRANTED; 4. Defendant Dutra is DISMISSED from the action without prejudice; and 5.
