This matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 21 636(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 22 On March 18, 2016, findings and recommendations were entered, recommending that this 23 action proceed on the third amended complaint against Defendant Valencia on Plaintiff's claim 24 of excessive force, and that the remaining claims and Defendants be dismissed. Plaintiff was 25 provided an opportunity to file objections within thirty days. Plaintiff has not filed objections to 26 the findings and recommendations. 27 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 305, this

Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 1 2 Court finds the record to be supported by the record and proper analysis. Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that: 3 4 1. The findings and recommendations issued by the Magistrate Judge on March 18, 5 2016, are adopted in full; 6 2. This action proceeds on the third amended complaint against Defendant C/O Valencia on Plaintiff's claim of excessive force. 7 8 3. Defendants Yates, Diez, Espino, King, O'Brien, Howard, Solo, Das, and Brown are dismissed for Plaintiff's failure to state a claim against them; 4.
