19 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by the parties, through their undersigned attorneys, and with the
 20 approval of the Court as provided below, that the Commissioner has agreed to a voluntary remand of this
 21 case pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further proceedings.

22 Upon remand, an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) will reassess claimant's credibility, as well as
 23 the weight afforded to treating source opinions, and take any additional action warranted by the
 24 evidence. Further, the ALJ will update the medical record. The claimant will be offered an opportunity
 25 for a hearing.
