Petitioner does not indicate where he was sentenced or convicted, but he 17 is incarcerated at Pleasant Valley State Prison in Coalinga, California, which is in the 18 Eastern District of California. 19 Venue for habeas cases involving state prisoners is proper in either the district of 20 confinement or the district of conviction. 28 U.S.C. 2241(d). The district of 21 confinement is the preferable forum to review the execution of a sentence, however. 22 Habeas L.R. 2254-3(a); Dunne v. Henman, 875 F.2d 244, 249 (9th Cir. 1989). Because 23 Petitioner challenges the execution of his sentence, rather than the validity of it, the 24 Eastern District of California is the preferable forum for his petition. 25 Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1404(a) and Habeas L.R. 2254-3(b), and in the interests of 26 justice, this petition is **Transferred** to the United States District Court for the Eastern
