20	a courtesy copy upon the Receiver's Office, requesting that they check to ensure that Plaintiff was		
21	not being removed from a necessary, effective treatment protocol arbitrarily and without a sound		
22	medical basis. The Court is in receipt of an informal response from the Receiver's Office, which		
23	was also sent to the Office of the Attorney General and Plaintiff.		
24	The Court will provide Plaintiff with an opportunity to address whether this informal		
25	response should be filed under seal. In his response Plaintiff needs to state why the document should		
26	be filed under seal if that is his request.
