(ECF No. 11.) Plaintiff 20 has failed to file objections. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(c) and Local Rule 305, this 21 22 Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: The Findings and Recommendations, filed June 4, 2012, are adopted in full; 1. 2. Plaintiff be allowed to proceed on his Fourteenth Amendment equal protection claim against Defendant Doran; Plaintiff's claims against Defendants Warden Harrington, Warden Biter, and 3. Associate Warden Lawless be dismissed with prejudice; and 4. Defendants Warden Harrington, Warden Biter, and Associate Warden Lawless be dismissed from this action. IT IS SO ORDERED. /s/ Lawrence J.
