Nos. 36, 46) 14 Defendant. 15 Plaintiff Rick Dixon is a former inmate proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this 16 civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action proceeds on plaintiff's fourth 17 amended complaint against defendant Allison for unconstitutional conditions of confinement for 18 denial of outdoor exercise in violation of the Eighth Amendment, denial of the right to religious 19 expression in violation of the First Amendment, and denial of access to the courts in violation of 20 the First Amendment. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 21 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 22 On November 18, 2016, defendant filed a motion to dismiss. (Doc. No. 36.) On August 23 3, 2017, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations, recommending that 24 defendant's motion to dismiss be granted in part. (Doc. No. 46.) The parties were provided 25 thirty days in which to file objections to those findings and recommendations. (Id.) To date, 26

neither party has filed objections, and the time for doing so has passed.

1	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a	
2	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the	
3	findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.	
4	Accordingly,	
5	1.	The findings and recommendations, filed August 3, 2017, are adopted in full and
6		defendant's motion to dismiss (Doc. No. 36) is granted in part and denied in part
7		as follows;
8	2.	Defendant's motion to dismiss the religious expression and access to courts
9		claims as barred by the statute of limitations is granted;
10	3.	Defendant's motion to dismiss the official capacity claims for monetary damages
11		is granted;
12	4.	Defendant's motion to dismiss the unconstitutional conditions of confinement
13		claim for denial of outdoor exercise on the ground that defendant is entitled to
14		qualified immunity is denied without prejudice to that issue being raised at a later
15		stage in these proceedings;
16	5.	Defendant's religious expression claim, access to courts claim, and official
17		capacity claims for monetary damages are dismissed;
18	6.	This action shall proceed only against defendant in her individual capacity with
19		respect to plaintiff's unconstitutional conditions of confinement claim for denial
20		of outdoor exercise in violation of the Eighth Amendment; and
21	7.	This matter is referred back to the magistrate judge for further proceedings
22		consistent with this order.
23	IT IS SO ORDERED.
