On December 10, 2014, the action 21 was dismissed for Plaintiff's failure to obey a court order and failure to prosecute. (ECF 22 No. 80.) Plaintiff appealed. (ECF No. 84.) 23 On January 5, 2015, the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit 24 referred the matter to this Court to determine whether Plaintiff's in forma pauperis status 25 should be revoked. (ECF No. 88.) This Court did not respond to the referral notice within 26 twenty-one days, and Plaintiff's in forma pauperis status therefore was continued 27

automatically pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 24(a).

Before the Court is Plaintiff's February 12, 2015 motion for continued in forma pauperis status on appeal. (ECF No. 90.)
