13	rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate
14	Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.
15	On April 5, 2012, 2011, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations
16	recommending that Plaintiff's motion for an emergency injunction be denied. (ECF No. 49.)
17	Plaintiff has failed to file objections to the Findings and Recommendations.
18	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(c) and Local Rule 305, this
