18	(Doc. 162) Consequently, the Court ordered dismissal documents to be filed no later than	
19	September 29, 2017. (Doc. 164 at 2) This did not occur. Thus, the Court ORDERS :	
20	1. <u>Within 14 days</u> , counsel and the parties SHALL show cause why sanctions	
21	including dismissal of the action and/or the imposition of monetary sanctions, should not be imposed	
22	for their failure to comply with the Court's orders. Alternatively, they may file the stipulated request	
23	for dismissal within 14 days.
