a person under this article is the court in which the money judgment is entered. 1 (b) A person sought to be examined may not be required to attend an examination 2 before a court located outside the county in which the person resides or has a place of business unless the distance from the person's place of residence or place of 3 business to the place of examination is less than 150 miles. 4 (c) If a person sought to be examined does not reside or have a place of business in the county where the judgment is entered, the superior court in the county where the 5 person resides or has a place of business is a proper court for examination of the 6 person. 7 Cal. Civ. Proc. Code §§ 708.160(a)-(c). 8 Plaintiff's application sets forth the showing required by Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 9 69(a)(2) and the applicable provisions of the California Code of Civil Procedure § 708.160. 10 III. **CONCLUSION** Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 11 Defendant/judgment debtor Juan Galindo shall appear personally on Wednesday, 12 1. May 9, 2012, at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 7 of the United States District Courthouse, 13 located at 2500 Tulare Street, Fresno, California, 93721, to answer questions 14 15 concerning Defendant/judgment debtor Juan Galindo's real and personal property; and 16 2. Plaintiff/judgment creditor must serve this order upon Juan Galindo personally not 17 less than 10 days before the date set for the examination and must file a certificate 18 19 of such service with the Court.
