Serrano ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in 19 forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. 20 Plaintiff initiated this action on April 20, 2006. (ECF No. 1.) On June 3, 2013, the 21 Court found that Plaintiff stated a cognizable Eighth Amendment claim against Defendant 22 Lucas. (ECF No. 11.) 23 On November 25, 2013, Defendant Lucas filed a motion to dismiss for failure to 24 exhaust administrative remedies. (ECF No. 21.) More than twenty-one days have passed 25 and Plaintiff has not filed an opposition or a statement of non-opposition to the motion. Local 26 Rule 230(1). 27 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:
