Petitioner United States of America (“the government”) initiated this enforcement action on March 11, 2011 against respondent Mike Briggs (“Mr. Briggs”). The Court was notified today that Mr. Briggs filed a bankruptcy action on February 18, 2011. The government moves to vacate all pending dates and to stay this action. This Court finds that these proceedings are stayed as a matter of law pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §362. Accordingly, and for good cause appearing, this Court:

- 1. VACATES all pending proceedings, including July 8, 2011 show cause order and the July 25, 2011 show cause hearing;
- 2. STAYS all further proceedings; and
- 3. ORDERS the government to file a status report no later than November 14, 2011.
