ORDER FOR IN CAMERA REVIEW OF
PERSONNEL FILES

(Doc. 80 – Amended Motion to Compel)

In the parties’ Local Rule 251 stipulation, Plaintiff requests an *in camera* review “of those documents listed in the Privilege Log and any other documents that Defendants refuse to provide without such review.” Doc. 85-2 at 147. Mindful of the claims of privilege and of privacy set forth in the Privilege Log(s), the Court nonetheless at this time orders an *in camera* review of the personnel files of the remaining individual defendants: Leticia Castaneda, Erica Soto, Ron Castaneda, Julia Langley, Carol Holding, and John Rozum. The Court continues to consider this discovery dispute (*see* July 15, 2013 minute order, Doc. 88), and may order an *in camera* review of other files at a later date.

Either the attorney for each defendant or the custodial officer for the defendant’s personnel file should schedule a convenient time, on or preferably before August 16, 2013, to deliver the

1 personnel file to Judge Snyder's chambers. Scheduling arrangements should be made through
2 Judge Snyder's deputy clerk, Ms. Michelle Rooney.
