21	This Court hereby directs Defendants' counsel to submit a supplemental declaration		
22	specifically identifying the billing entries used in calculation of each such time total. Counsel is		
23	further directed to break down each such total to reflect time allocated to Plaintiff's counsel and to		
24	counsel's paralegal assistant.		
25	Counsel is directed to submit his supplemental declaration on or before May 11, 2012.		
26	Although the Court does not anticipate any need for Plaintiff to submit any response to the requested		
27	supplemental declaration, should Plaintiff feel a response is necessary, it shall be submitted to the		
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1	Court on or before May 16, 2012. The matter shall then be deemed submitted for decision pursuant		
2	to Local Rule 230(h) (Fed. R. Civ. P. 78).
