"The Court shall retain jurisdiction of this action to enforce provisions of this Order for twelve (12) months after the date of this Consent Decree, or until the injunctive relief contemplated by this Order is completed, whichever occurs later."

The issue of the Court declining to retain jurisdiction in any of Ms. Moore's cases arose specifically in Daniel Delgado v. Big 5 Sporting Goods Corporation and Stephen Investments, Inc., USDC Case No. 1:11-cv-02024-SMS, on or about April 18, 2012,

1 after the Consent Decree was signed in the above-captioned case.
