parties and contained notice that any objections were to be filed within fifteen (15) days. (Doc. 6.) To date, no party has filed objections. In accordance with the provisions of Title 28 of the United States Code section 636 (b)(1)(c), this Court has conducted a *de novo* review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds that the Findings and Recommendations are supported by the record and proper analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The Findings and Recommendations dated July 11, 2011, are ADOPTED IN FULL; and 2. Based on the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff Martha Scalzo's Motion for Remand for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction be GRANTED and that this action be REMANDED to the Madera County Superior Court of California, for all further proceedings. This Order terminates this action in its entirety. IT IS SO ORDERED. /s/ Lawrence J. O'Neill
