The action was transferred to this Court on May 13 5, 2011, and designated as a regular pro se action. On May 10, 2011, the action was re-designated as 14 a prisoner civil rights action. 15 Upon further review, it has been determined that Plaintiff filed the present action when he 16 was unincarcerated. Thus, Local Rule 230(1) is not applicable and this action should be designated a 17 regular pro se action.
