In this action, claimants filed their February 6, 2014 application 25

("application") to seek this Court's order to require the U.S. Marshal to release to claimants

more than \$34,000 ("funds") and interests in Kern County oil and gas leases ("leases"),

pursuant to the writ of execution. The release of the funds apparently was not addressed by the

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prior district judge assigned to this case before his retirement. This Court will not rule on the application without providing an opportunity to others claiming an interest in the funds and leases to respond to the application. As such this Court: 1. ORDERS any response to claimant's application to be filed and served no later than March 13, 2014; 2. ORDERS claimants to serve a copy of this order on the judgment debtors; and 3.
