Accordingly, the last date for Plaintiff to file an 2 3 opening brief was January 17, 2012. On January 17, 2012, Plaintiff failed to timely file an opening brief with the Court and no 4 5 opening brief has been filed to date. 6 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 7 1. Plaintiff shall **either**: 8 SHOW CAUSE, by filing a written statement, why his case should not be a. 9 recommended for dismissal for failure to comply with the Court's scheduling 10 order; or File an opening brief on or before February 24, 2012; and 11 b. 12 2.
