10	(5) A statement that claims of persons entitled to possession
11	or claiming an interest pursuant to Supplemental Rule G(5) must be filed with the
12	Court and served on the attorney for the Plaintiff no later than 60 days after the
13	first day of publication on the official internet government forfeiture site; and
14	(6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion
15	under Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be
16	filed and served within 21 days after the filing of the claims and, in the absence
17	thereof, default may be entered and condemnation ordered.
