(Doc. 4 at 5) When Plaintiff failed to file objections and after the 14 days had 22 expired, on August 22, 2011, the Court adopted the findings and recommendations and dismissed 23 the case. (Doc. 5) 24 On August 24, 2011, Plaintiff filed objections to the findings and recommendations. (Doc. 25

7) This case, however, is closed. Therefore, any document filed herein, including the instant amended complaint, will be disregarded. No further orders will be issued in this case.

¹The Court notes that Plaintiff failed to provide any showing in his objections, that he had, indeed, complied with the Federal Tort Claims Act and, instead impliedly admits that he did not do so. (Doc. 7 at 2, 8-10)
