17	Plaintiff John Edwards Mitchell ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in a civi

19	complaint on Defendants Indermill and Pena. (Doc. 27).	
20	On July 30, 2013, the Court denied Plaintiff's prior request for an order directing service	
21	(Doc. 25). Namely, the Court advised Plaintiff that its first order directing service of his complain	
22	remained in effect and the U.S. Marshals will serve Defendants Indermill and Pena in due course. <u>Id</u>	
23	The Court further advised Plaintiff that he may voluntarily submit updated information as to the	
24	whereabouts of Defendants Indermill and Pena to further effectuate service; which Plaintiff has no	
25	done. <u>Id</u> . Plaintiff provides no further grounds for the Court to reconsider its prior order.
