20	the Court on October 5, 2012. (Docs. 12 & 31). On October 22, 2012, petitioner filed a notice

22	petitioner's application to proceed in forma pauperis reveals that petitioner is unable to afford the
23	costs of an appeal. Accordingly, the application to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal is
24	GRANTED. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915. The Clerk is directed to serve a copy of this order on the
25	Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit.
