ORDER ON STIPULATION TO STAY
DISCOVERY AND GRANTING AN
EXTENSION OF TIME TO ADVISE RE
SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE

17 Plaintiffs are state prisoners who were confined in the Security Housing Unit (“SHU”) at
18 the California Correctional Institution (“CCI”) in Tehachapi. (Doc. 19 at 2.) The dispositive
19 motion filing deadline has lapsed and trial is set for July 28, 2015 before the Honorable Anthony
20 W. Ishii. (*See* Docs. 48, 58.) Thus, the parties were asked to submit statements regarding
21 whether a settlement conference would be of assistance. (Doc. 59.) In response, the parties filed
22 a stipulation to stay discovery indicating Plaintiffs have provided Defendants a demand and
23 Defendants are in process of evaluating it. (Doc. 60) They indicate that, at this time, they have
24 agreed to suspend further discovery until Defendants respond and that they would like to delay
25 response to the Court’s inquiry related to a settlement conference until that time.

26 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- 27 (1) discovery in this matter is stayed until **February 27, 2015**; and
28 (2) no later than **February 27, 2015**, the parties shall submit statements indicating

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whether they believe, in good faith, settlement is a possible and whether they wish
the Court to set a settlement conference.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
