15	Plaintiff Walter Rapalo is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this		
16	civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C	C. § 1983. On October 12, 2011, the Court ordered Plaintiff	
17	to either consent to or decline Magistr	ate Judge jurisdiction within thirty days. Plaintiff failed to	
18	comply, and on November 29, 2011,	the Court issued a second order requiring Plaintiff to file a	

20 or otherwise responded to the Court's orders.

Local Rule 110 provides that "failure of counsel or of a party to comply with these Local
Rules or with any order of the Court may be grounds for the imposition by the Court of any and all
sanctions . . . within the inherent power of the Court." Further, the failure of Plaintiff to prosecute
this action is grounds for dismissal. <u>In re Phenylpropanolamine (PPA) Products Liability Litigation</u>,
460 F.3d 1217, 1226 (9th Cir. 2006).
