Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), Plaintiff consented to the jurisdiction of 20 the United States Magistrate Judge on November 1, 2011. Local Rule 302. 21 On January 24, 2014, the undersigned dismissed Plaintiff's complaint for failure to state a 22 claim upon which relief may be granted and ordered Plaintiff to file an amended complaint within 23 thirty days. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A; 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e). To date, Plaintiff has not complied with or 24 otherwise responded to the Court's order. As a result, there is no pleading on file which sets forth any 25 claims upon which relief may be granted under section 1983. 26 /// 27 /// 28

Accordingly, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e), it is HEREBY ORDERED that this action is dismissed, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state any claims upon which relief may be granted under section 1983.
